RESEARCHING ACUPUNCTURE

Complexity in the study of acupuncture

Thursday 20.00 - 22.00 Evening Lecture

The basis of acupuncture theory and practice has not been investigated much by the scientific community. If this situation is to improve we must start doing this work ourselves.

Stephen has developed a grass-roots research agenda focusing on small-scale exploratory studies. He will present an overview of this work and hopes to inspire colleagues and researchers to establish similar agendas on a larger scale.

Words like science, research and methodology are often considered as belonging to the people with higher degrees doing big research projects. However, you can look at each of your patients as a small research project you are going to solve. Anette will share her own experiences on how simple methods can be used to benefit the outcome of treatments as well as the knowledge from experience.

The state of play and challenges facing the field

Saturday 9.00 - 12.30 Joint Lecture

What have we learned so far about the efficacy of acupuncture from clinical trials? What have we learned from scientific studies about the validity of traditionally based diagnoses and their conceptual bases, such as the jingmai and the acupoints? What has been done with this evidence and what challenges are posed by this? While the evidence in these areas has been slowly developing, it is not so strong which has led acupuncture's critics to become more active, creating a number of challenges for the field. What can the field do to start addressing these evidence gaps? How can the colleges of acupuncture and the professional organizations contribute? Stephen Birch and Hugh MacPherson will draw on their research experiences and knowledge of the field as practitioners and instructors to present these summaries. Following this there will be contributions from the TCM umbrella organization, the ETCMA for the professional associations, and from the Oslo University College of Acupuncture, leading to further discussion and debate on the future role and direction of research.
