Lillian Garnier Bridges

Lillian Garnier Bridges is an internationally recognized and acclaimed speaker, teacher and author. Lillian's warmth, humour and insight captivate her audiences and have made her one of the top lecturers at symposiums and conferences around the world. A Professor of Oriental Medicine, she is known for bringing back the study of facial diagnosis to the field. Founder of the Lotus Institute, she trains students and consults with major corporations. Originally learning facial diagnosis, feng shui, and five element theory apprenticing with her Chinese mother's family, Lillian has spent over 20 years researching information from ancient texts and correlating them to Western studies in psychology and medicine, ergonomics and design. She has been featured on numerous television and radio shows and in magazines. Her book, Face Reading in Chinese Medicine has just been published by Churchill Livingstone. Face Reading and Facial Diagnosis teach how to assess personality and health from the biological blueprint of the face - an invaluable tool for seeing into the body and mind. At the congress Lillian Garnier Bridges will be lecturing on "Primal Sexuality and Creativity from the Source – Jing and Desire" and "Signs of Sexuality on the Face".

Ilkay Zihni Chirali

Ilkay Zihni Chirali was born in 1946 in the village Lemba (Chirali) Gazi Baf, Cyprus. He left Cyprus to pursue his higher education, first in Turkey and then in Sweden and England. In 1982 he emigrated to study Chinese Medicine in Australia with his wife and two children. He qualified as an acupuncturist in Melbourne, Australia, where he opened his first Acupuncture and Stress Therapy Clinic. He returned to England in 1987 and now has two clinics, one in Eltham, south-east London and one in Tottenham, North London, where he treats children and adults. His wide-ranging studies have brought him expertise in Acupuncture, Chinese Herbal Medicine, Clinical Hypnotherapy, The Lusher Personality Test, Paediatric Acupuncture and Western Medicine Pathology. He has studied further in Nanjing, China, at the College of Traditional Chinese Medicine and First Affiliated Hospital in the Internal Medicine, Dermatology and Gynaecology departments. He has been organising structured seminars and workshops around the world since 1988. To date he has given over 25 public lectures and a BBC World Service Radio talk on the subject of Traditional Chinese Medicine and Cupping Therapy. He is the author of "Cupping Therapy" first published by Churchill Livingstone in 1999. At the congress Ilkay Zihni Chirali will be giving a workshop on "Hands-on Cupping Therapy".

Hamid Montakab

Dr. Hamid Montakab finished his medicine- and acupuncture studies in 1975 in Paris and spent his time as medical registrar in the surgery and gynaecology departments of Poitiers. During his three-year study of acupuncture he spent four months at the Men Wa and ISA schools in Hong Kong,

and after this he spent further time studying in the Philippines and in India. In India he stayed three years working and combining TCM with Allopathy and Ayurveda. Between 1980 and 1985 he worked in the USA and received diplomas from the "Oregon Acupuncture Board" and the "National Acupuncture Board (NCCA)". In the following years he further expanded his knowledge of herbs, Osteopathy and the visceral Osteopathy in Europe. Dr. Montakab has carried out research in "Acupuncture and Sleep disturbances" as well as studies of the diseases of the skin at the University of Geneva. Dr. Montakab was commissioned by the Swiss National Fond to conduct a scientific research study on Acupuncture and Insomnia. He has also done a smaller study on Acupuncture in Atrophic Dermatitis at the Geneva University Hospital. Since 1985 he has been working and teaching in Switzerland, France and Germany. Between 1995 and 2000 he was the co-founder and president of the Swiss Professional Organisation for TCM (SBO-TCM). In 1986 he founded the Academy for Chinese Healing Arts in Switzerland together with his wife Solange. Hamid Montakab combines immense knowledge of eastern and western medicine with his years of practice in Europe, India, China and the USA. Students from all over the world have harvested the fruits of this extensive knowledge for several years. At the congress Dr. Montakab will be lecturing on "Energetics of Pregnancy and Birth in Classical Chinese medicine".
